- 1.Lack of Concrete Data: This research paper lacks concrete numerical data or statistical analysis which could have strengthened the arguments made. Without them, it is unable to provide quantitative evidence to substantiate its points.

- 4. Absence of Counter-Arguments: The paper only presents the imperative need for geoscience literacy among urbanites, not considering or acknowledging any counter-arguments or limitations that might exist. It thus fails to provide a comprehensive, balanced view of the subject.
- 5.Unanswered Questions: Despite discussing the importance of geoscience literacy, it does not give thorough suggestions or strategies about how geoscience literacy could be improved among urbanites.

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
