Regarding the methodological analysis, it is adequate and follows structures and processes that guarantee the analysis carried out. However, the validity of the questionnaires as measurement tools used is not sufficiently clear.

The results are well indicated and reflected according to the methodological tools used, and these yield significant values and data.

The comparison and discussion with the findings in similar publications and studies provide outstanding validity to the results obtained.

The work can be publishable, assessing by other observers the adequate validation of the methodological tools used.
