Review of: "Franciscana's (*Pontoporia blainvillei*) Diving and Surface Times Through Drone Monitoring"

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For this endemic species in a specific region, the implementation of this study is of great significance. Firstly, solid baseline population information is an important prerequisite for conservation work. Although there are important protected areas, the basic information needs to be updated in a timely manner, which is also crucial for subsequent work. Secondly, based on our experience, the behavior of animals is closely related to the environment and food resources. Therefore, the investigation of relevant environmental factors must be carried out simultaneously.
