The topic of the manuscript is interesting and useful. The manuscript is written well; however, authors may make some modifications to improve their manuscript's clarity.

1- In the methods or results section, the participation rate or level was not determined. We know that sexuality is a culture- and social-sensitive issue; therefore, those who did not participate may have such barriers. It is important to know the total target group and the percentage who participated. Also, among those who did not participate, what percentage was due to failure to provide parental consent, or if there was another reason behind.

2- The explanation about the tools used in this study was not sufficient to provide an understanding of positive or negative attitudes.

3- The authors performed an analysis based on education division but did not provide any discussion about the possible impact of educational background on knowledge and attitudes toward sexuality.
