Review of: "Kienböck's Disease May Be Due to a Wrist-Joint Tamponade"

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The author has improved the text significantly with a more precise and focused abstract that is clearer and directly states the hypothesis (wrist-joint tamponade as a cause of Kienböck's disease). Also, there is stronger terminology and conceptual clarity, and improved coherence in the conclusions. The comparison to muscle compartment syndrome is clearer and helps justify the proposed treatment, which in my opinion could have potential use.

In summary, the current version is significantly better; it proposes a novel and plausible hypothesis, and I would recommend proceeding with publication.
