Page 1

- Run-on sentences. For example, the first sentence in the abstract. Three complete sentences should not be separated by commas. Avoid passive voice, such as "that has been going through Brazil." There is no verb in this sentence: "How memory technologies help environmental activism?" so this is not a full sentence, it is a clause.
- · Clarify "oscillates between governments directives."
- Stylistic: "practice by the common people is very common," repeating word
- "by that we are saying" Haven't established who "we" is yet.
- Clarify the importance/meaning of "to bring the experience of the environmental preservation concerns"

Page 2

- "Augmented Reality technology although isn't relatively new, still has applications that we don't have sufficient research and data." Missing preposition.
- "interator??"
- "Forest's conservation" apostrophe?
- "and had an incredible deforestation process since the 1970's" tense agreement?

Page 3

- The legend in the map is in Portuguese, not English.
- Clarify "The green one" Do you mean the green region?
- "now we can seen" What verb tense?

Page 4

• "The region represented in Figures are distant" missing an article.

Page 5

- "how much vegetation was ripped off and how much effort will be taken to bring one of the several areas back to normality." Improper verb "ripped off"
- "So, we got a two part job: first choose a place and take a photo so we can get the image mark for the AR. Second we must model and render trees and other plants from the local environment." The grammar in the sentence needs



significant editing. Are you explaining the steps you took? Or what needs to be done?

• Grammar: "get as high as" also, use of the word "got" later in this paragraph.

Page 6

- "After that to do the image marker we choose to take a shot from" grammar
- · "digital tree" clarify
- In the paragraph beginning with "The most difficult," you need to decide if you want to stick with present tense or past tense.
- "any photo in digital archives" missing an article

Page 7

• Both images are named "figure 6"

Page 8

- "As we had a short deadline and with the difficulties to find more references it was possible to show only one layer."

 Run-on sentence.
- "new planted trees" needs to be an adverb.
- · Several grammar errors, needs a line editor
- Clarify the thesis. The point of this paper is to describe the project and communicate what the next steps will be? (top of page 2)
- You set up the need for this type of monitoring well by outlining the history of the region.
- On page 5, you claim to have shown how much effort will be needed to reforest back to normal tree-cover, however, you have in no way quantified hectares, or cost, or any quantity of anything. How much what? And what kind of effort?
- What is your modeling and rendering methodology? When you begin to say "the problem that we faced was the
 enormous amount of polygons used to make a full scale tree," this is unclear because you did not outline your
 methodology and the reader does not know what you are referring to.
- It appears you are advocating for certain tree species to be used in the art you are doing (with figure 6), while the imaging in figures 1, 2, and 3 are referring to coverage. There is a bit of a disconnect with what you are advocating/what your thesis is. Please clarify.
- It concerns me that only two references are cited. I'm sure much more research in this area already exists. How do you know that your research is original and contributory?
