Shift the focus from descriptive to explanatory, substantiating claims with references. For example, introduce sections like "What is the Educational Chat Network (EdChat)'s Solution?" and "Open Reviews," and support statements with references for credibility.

The link between EdChat and academic equity, as mentioned in the title, needs clarification. Explicitly address how EdChat contributes to or should be praised for promoting academic diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Methodology: The methodology is based on three elements: (1) Literature review, (2) Platform analysis, and (3) Al consultation using ChatGPT. However, the last two methods lack explanation on how they were conducted. Provide detailed explanations of the processes involved in platform analysis and Al consultation to enhance transparency and replicability. Consider incorporating elements of a systematic review, ensuring validity and reliability in the research design.

Recommendation: It is suggested that the study be revamped by incorporating systematic review elements, considering the rigor of systematic review (SR) methodology. Emphasize the validity and reliability of the study findings to contribute more robustly to knowledge in the field.



In summary, revising the manuscript based on these recommendations will enhance the overall clarity, coherence, and rigor of the study, providing a more valuable contribution to the academic literature.
