

Review of: "Comparing the Effectiveness of Aloe Vera Gel and 2% Chlorhexidine Gluconate Solution in Preventing Phlebitis Caused by Peripheral Vein Catheters in Hospitalized Patients"

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The authors have demonstrated the positive anti-inflammatory properties of aloe vera gel in reducing the incidence of phlebitis during catheterization. I have a few questions for the author of the text:

- In the methods section, after the first sentence, it says "they got" what exactly does this refer to?
- In the text, you mention that **Table 4** represents the frequency of phlebitis; is this a mistake considering that only Table 1 is shown in the paper?
- What do you mean by "cc of aloe vera and 2% chlorhexidine gel"?
- You sometimes refer to it as a 2% chlorhexidine gel and other times as a 2% chlorhexidine solution—what was actually used?
