Under Introduction, paragraph 2

Line 2 As healthcare costs continue **torise**, not **expand**

Line 8 & 9: should rather read, 'This review will first discuss the biologically active cinnamon compound, followed by discussion on a selection of recent cinnamon and cancer studies according to the potential mechanism of action, including the targeting of transcription factors and kinases.'

Under 2.0 (Biologically Active Cinnamon Compounds)

Paragraph 1, line 3: Cinnamic acid ----- 'are' also important components and not 'have are'

Paragraph 1, line 5 ----- potential biological activity (' not suspected' )

Paragraph 2, line 3 ----- screened based "on" and not "of"

Paragraph 2, line 4: Write 127 in words and put 147 in brackets

Paragraph 2, line 9: Should read, these are involved in lipid metabolism.

Paragraph 3, line 1: there should be a comma after *et al*, and not a full stop

Paragraph 3, line: Provide a strong, not an strong

Paragraph 3, line 6: PCB2 has been shown----- and not PCB2 has shown-----

Paragraph 4, line 4: There are many different studies that "presented" and not "represent"

Paragraph 4, line 10: The result “included” not “includes”
