- 4. In section 2.4, academic writing style is not followed. Words like "you" are not encouraged in academic writing.
- 5. The Discussion section needs to be elaborated by making an attempt to generate managerial implications for Micro, Small and Medium enterprises separately.
- 6. The Conclusion section of the paper is too generic.
- 7. Overall, the paper fails to highlight the novel outcomes from the analysis. Rigour is required to make it publishable.
