- 1. Authors should provide clear evidence for their main argument that Dengue patients were misdiagnosed as malaria or typhoid fever.
- There are several places where the numbers do not match. One of the examples is the following. The authors said the
 total patient number was 1074, then the malaria-positive cases were 741, and the typhoid-positive cases were 333.
 The added numbers became 1047.
- 3. More concise and clear data presentation is needed. Some of the data looks redundant.
- 4. References for the critical arguments need to be strengthened.

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
