- 5. The Research Methodology section should justify the reason for choosing Benin University students to conduct this research. The use of sampling techniques should be consistent. Either random or purposive sampling would be appropriate for this study. The author/s should also clarify how instrument validity was ensured. The inclusion of pilot testing would make more sense in this regard. The sampling size should be justified. Besides, how the authors obtained the ethical clearance for data collection needs to be explicitly outlined based on the university policy.
- 6. The author/s can elaborate on the theoretical and managerial implications of this study.
- 7. The study should outline the limitations and future directions at the end.
- 8. The recommendations need to be revised according to the convention of research articles.
