- 06. Check the writing format of equations in the manuscript.
- 07. For "(Cu=77.3mg/kg, Mo= 1.4 mg/kg, and Cd=1.9)", add unit of "Cd=1.9".
- 08. Add the limitations of your study to discussion.
- 09. Introduction is short, add more information regarding health effects of metals.
- 10. Extend Conclusion and add more numerical results to it.
