Although an important issue is addressed in the article I reviewed, the article needs revisions. My notes, in order: Abbreviations should not be used in the abstract content. The summary should include statistical data on coping mechanisms.

What is the feature or reason for preference of the chosen scale for the measurement of anxiety? I could not see the scale permissions and ethics committee information.

In the introduction, the need for the study is expressed in detail, but the purpose of the study is not included.

Anxiety is a constantly present emotion, there may be many factors affecting students' anxiety, moreover, the questionnaire statements can be misinterpreted for this reason, I think that the data collection method is weak, this has already been stated in the limitations.

What is the correlation coefficient of the scales used in the study, was a pilot study conducted before data collection? the tables are missing,

the data in the discussion could not be fully addressed with the literature, I could not see current article information in the discussion, also the references is very old, the last five years could have been taken as a basis,

The recommendations of the study should be shared more objectively.
