- 3. Under Analysis of Data, ...and the konjac phenomenon for well-beingwere also analyzed descriptively...
- 4. under The Process for Domesticating Konjac, there need to define what is meant by "ngabolang" for novice to understand and appreciate
- 5. Format Table 3. Proper formatting will have it on a page
