1. There is a need to indicate explicitly in the abstract the data collection methods (e.g., interviews, survey questionnaires), and the data analysis methods (i.e., qualitative and quantitative).
2. The comment in 1 also should apply in the main body under the methodology and data analysis sections; it should be indicated there as well, clearly.
3. In the results, it should explicitly be written that they are qualitative/quantitative results being presented.
