*Behaviour Change Intervention Ontology (BCIO)*

**Definition:** A spatial that inheres in a bearer by virtue of its position relative to other entities.

**Informal definition:** Where a person, animal or object is.

**Comment:** An intervention could be used to rearrange objects in an environment, changing the location of a person relative to these objects and thereby increasing the likelihood of a behaviour.
