- In this study, much of the work has been ignored, including significant research. The author does not cite an appropriate range of literature related to the subject.
- The motivation/problem statement, significant, objective, research methodology, in the introduction section are required to be explained.
- The figures are not clear.
- The results presented in this study require further explanation,
