- 3. Hypothesis is missing.
- 4. Methodology: You have close to 70 items (including demographic variables); however, the sample size is only 276. How would you justify the same?
- 5. What were your control variables?
- 6. How did you approach respondents? How many respondents did you approach?
- 7. As you have collected data in two phases, what all did you collect (which items) in the first phase and the second phase?
- 8. It would be nice if the authors could include a model depicting the relationship of all the variables.
- 9. Did you perform any tests to check the common method variance problem?
- 10. It would be better to have separate sections for managerial implications, research implications, limitations, and scope for future research direction.
