A recombinant form of the heterodimeric human anterior pituitary glycoprotein thyroidstimulating hormone (TSH) with potential use in hormone replacement therapy. Recombinant TSH binds to TSH receptors on thyroid epithelial cells and stimulates TSHdependent signaling pathways. This stimulates iodine uptake and organification, and induces synthesis and secretion of thyroglobulin (Tg), triiodothyronine (T3), and thyroxine (T4).
