- Well written paper on the present accessibility status of educational institutions in Delhi as per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017
- The study evaluated institutions complains with the five-year time limit from 15.06.2017 as prescribed by the RPwDs Act 2016.
- Only 14 out of 27 reported being complaint with accessibility standards
- The authors didn't investigate the reasons for noncompliance.
- Is it due to want of funds/grands-in-aid?
- · Problems faced by the physically challenged students and staff were not presented
- · They suggested that to increase accessibility to resources, empowerment, and change in mindset
