- 2. Some words need revision as they might reduce the clarity of the text and can be better replaced; also, the use of highly relevant words could be revised.
- 3. "The need and possibility of integrating Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED) principles into the built environment for crime reduction in New Delhi." Is a repeated sentence in the aim and again in the objective.
- 4. The selection criteria of the crime reports could be mentioned based on their environmental impact and other related predefined criteria in the text, which gives more justification for the choice.
- 5. It would be an additive contribution to select a case study and apply the operable variables of the CPTED dimensions so they could be taken into consideration for further research and study, even if it reached a framework or matrix to be applied.
