I appreciate the ideas behind this work and agree that the aims are important, urgent and valuable. At present, however, this paper works as a proposal for a larger paper that would require far deeper and more expansive research, references and theoretical discussion in several possible areas:

- an overview of the deforestation of the area that has been focused on, written in a way that is comprehensive yet carefully contextualised and accessible to audiences outside Brazil and without local knowledge of the natural history and ecological degradation of the area
- a philosophical and aesthetic discussion as to the value of rendering images in AR, including possible other examples of similar work
- deeper exploration of the process of creating the work, interweaving with the above
- possible viewer response to the work and the effect the exhibition has/had on them
- a theoretical discussion of the educational value of this type of work and its implications for social change

All of these would require a rich resource of references and research in their own right.

Once these have been done, I would strongly recommend hiring an English-language editor who can enable the intended meaning of the authors to come through with clear precision, and in a way that does good justice to the work.
