The paper builds on a previous author's work comparing the current situation of the resilience to virus outbreak in a real estate context with this earlier predictive study. The language used in the text is well edited. The author touches on matters related to the impact of pandemics, such as COVID-19, on the resilience of urban real estate and interestingly identifies underlying conditions such as immigrant labor that affect urban development. However, it is not easy for the reader to identify the main areas of focus and the added value the exemplary presentation of cases brings to research on this topic. A more thorough literature review could improve this and provide a more accurate picture of the state-of-the-art in the sector.
