After reviewing the article, I suggest some issues that require minor changes:

- 1.- General comments
- The title doesn't mention the case study. The reader then doesn't expect to find an explicit reference or information about Hass avocado plantations. It is suggested to mention it in the title.
- The use of the first person singular does not seem appropriate.
- The use of a combination of qualitative methodologies is positively valued.
- 2.- Theoretical framework
- The theoretical framework presented is solid and correctly referenced. The bibliography is adequate and up-to-date. However, its methodological application is not clear. This point is raised as one of the weak points of this article.
- It is suggested to include a diagram or graph that helps the reader understand the relationship that exists between the theoretical framework and the method.
- A change of structure is proposed in section 2.4: This section 2.4. (and the following) could be renamed (as section 3) to dedicate it to the methodology applied to the case study.
