The scientific document presented, although it looks more like a technical report, contains many proxy variables, which makes it very confusing. It is understood that the authors attempted to describe an urban development phenomenon, but no evidence is presented about its causes, only the effects. The results must be written in the past tense and in the third person. It is recommended that the authors focus on one variable at a time and dig deeper with more evidence, especially population-based and not just map-based. One opportunity is that the evidence can be supplemented with photographic evidence. Another opportunity is the recovery of ethnographic evidence about the evolution of neighborhoods and their cultural activities.
