- 7. An argument for the inclusion of the other control variables should be mentioned briefly and why their selection.
- 8. The results and discussion of a paper is the main engine of a paper; an ultimate reader would read this section with great interest but the authors fail to write the discussion in proper way with comparing the findings of the previous studies. Special attention should be paid on the section. The discussion how Energy, Energy policies, Energy Supply, Energy Crises and Policy Analysis contributes to achieving the intended objectives in Nigeria and United Kingdom is not sufficient in my point of view. It should be accompanied by the current situation of Nigeria and United Kingdom.
- 9. Policy part is too narrow to make it publishable. It should be based on the empirical findings and present scenarios of the Nigeria and United Kingdom in a relevant matter and country specific.
- 10. Limitations of the research and future research pathway should be added
