The introduction is very short, it should be more comprehensive and more detailed.

The objectives need to be more organized (including bullets) like this:

- To measure the light levels inside the common eating area at various locations.
- To review daylighting regulations and learn about the different rooms' lighting needs in a space.
- To evaluate the specified number of openings and windows in order to meet the required lux levels.

In the literature review, it is better to provide a study which is about daylighting in an eating area such as a restaurant because the main focus of the current study is on the eating area of the educational institute.

In the methodology part, it should be explained about all points (A-F) because it is not clear what these points are.

In the Inferences, use "Results" instead of Inferences. Moreover, it needs to be explained about the lighting conditions of tables more clearly.

The conclusion part should also be more detailed like the introduction.
