This is an inspiring paper addressing the value of community development and neighbourliness. Although the content is impressive and very interesting to read, I would have liked more references and examples to support certain statements that, although agreeable to me, need evidence to stand in a paper. For instance, although the value of working on the roots (relationships) rather than the activities/programmes is reasonable at first sight, it would be even more compelling if backed up by evidence and/or examples proving the statement. As the audience may not be aware of the ABCD approach, some further explanation would be wise. More examples of neighbourhoods that are connected societies may also add to the evidence proving the validity of the paper's argumentation. All in all, it was a very interesting and easy read.
