- The abstract should be accompanied by some keywords,
- It is necessary to focus on specific issues and provide a more concise and compact presentation. The discussion of sexuality is too broad and extensive,
- It is advisable to pay attention to good organization and structure in presenting information to facilitate the reader's understanding of the author's flow of presentation,
- The design and data analysis have not been aligned between the abstract and the presentation in the methods section. In the abstract, it is mentioned that this article uses a phenomenological design with content analysis, while the presentation in the methods section does not describe the intended design and analysis, and it appears that data presentation adheres to two paradigms, namely naturalistic and positivistic,
- The conclusions should be made concise and to the point,
- Formulating recommendations and implications of the findings is necessary,
- Updating the list of references is needed.
