- 1. The article is relevant and presents a topic of interest for academic communication in this field of study.

- 3. The document provides theoretical elements of interest to the field of knowledge, however, some of the references used are more than five years old. Given the growing literature on this subject, more recent references should be used.
- 4. The summary must conform to the IMRD methodology.
- 5. The methodology used in the literature review should be made explicit and the procedure and databases consulted should be mentioned. Similarly, quantitative data of the bibliometric study, if it has been carried out, should be included.
- 6. The results shown in the review should be included in a section with that title and an introductory paragraph should be written explaining the theoretical categories in which those findings fall.
- 7. Adjust the conclusion with more in-depth comments that take up the objective of the article and relate possible emerging lines of work.
