The author has attempted to compose an interesting review correlating GI microbiome and ocular disorders. However, the current form of manuscripts does have some major and minor changes.

Some of the minor changes

- Lack of consistency and abbreviations
- Methods missing to accommodate most of the relevant articles
- A figure would be great to have to show the schematic of how these two systems are connected.
- "ophthalmology", "gut", and "microbiome" are broad terms and may provide other associated sources that may not be associated with the focus of the review.

Some of the suggested major changes.

- Author need to include the major scope of this review, for example, ocular disorders are a broader term, and if authors intend to cover all the ocular disorders and associated articles with them. The current scope of review seems to be very limited and authors may want to focus on a set of ocular diseases based on disease enrichment or other methods.
- Author needs to separate the human and animal studies and may want to explain the correlation and differences.
- Author may want to use tools e.g. PRISMA-S for publication search and expand the scope of the search.
- The current version is missing a concrete conclusion and recommendations based on the review article for future research.
