The article constitutes substantial research. Though, some issues should be addressed:

- 1. Althouth the purpose of the study is underlined, the added value of the research (including the contribution of the study to the field) is not highlighted.
- 2. It is not clear how the levels of knowledge are determined by the questionnaire. A sample of the questionnaire (including the respective questions) could contribute to a better understanding of the knowledge levels.
- T-test is not a competent statistical method to indicate impact. T-test can only point out tendencies and differences, but a more robust statistical technique should be used to validate the t-test results. Otherwise, the findings cannot be generalized.
- 4. English proofreading is necessary.
