

Review of: "Analysis of Factors Influencing Health and Safety Programme in Selected Electricity Distribution Companies"

I have reviewed the article titled "Analysis of Factors Influencing Health and Safety Program in Selected Electricity Distribution Companies". The title of the study is interesting; however, there are some concerns regarding the level of innovation and the methodology used. In order to improve the article, I suggest addressing the following points:

- 1) The introduction part is nearly appropriate, but it would benefit from a clear description of the existing research gap and the innovative aspects of the study.
- 2) The "Empirical Review" section only includes three studies, with excessive and unnecessary information provided about each. It would be beneficial to include more studies and provide a concise summary of each one.
- 3) The "Methodology" section includes explanations about the statistical population and sampling method, but lacks information about the data collection tools and their psychometric characteristics. This gap should be addressed in the text.
- 4) I recommend changing the title of section 4 to "Findings" or "Results".
- 5) The "Discussion" section is written in a poor and brief manner. It would greatly benefit from a more careful discussion of the study's findings and a comparison with a larger number of relevant studies.
- 6) It is important to mention the limitations of the study.
- 7) The recommendations section needs improvement. Additionally, in addition to practical recommendations, it would be valuable to provide suggestions for future studies in the same field.

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
