Review of: "Neoreaction, Accelerationism, Entrepreneurship"

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This is a well-written commentary based on rich literature which encompasses the relevant dimensions of the subject matter. The intertwined relations between neoreaction and acceleration, and then between them both and entrepreneurship, are very interesting.

Some more discussion of the term 'exit' (end of the first paragraph, using a footnote might be a good solution) as well as reterritorialisation (2nd p, top) is needed.

Also, turning to Land in the third paragraph could use some explanation. Why him? Did he contribute significantly to the acceleration discussion, and so on. At the end of the 2nd long paragraph (maybe there is a way to divide it), the reader could use some explanation of why exit is impossible under these conditions.

But overall, it's an interesting piece and worth publishing.
