Here are my general comments.

- "Title" From the perspective of the atmospheric sciences, "Weathering changes" and "Climatic changes" are completely different concepts. Please consider rephrasing the title of your manuscript in correspondence to its contents.
- 2. In abstract, please consider including key statistics (e.g., SPEI or change in migration) in 1-2 concise sentence.
- 3. "Research Question" If your intention is to highlight the research question, then please list out those questions. Explanation or motivation for addressing those questions should go to "Introduction" section. Also, there seem to be a lot of topics you are trying to address, which is admirable but please focus on the one which has highest priority.
- 4. "Data" Please focus on data used for the analysis ONLY. The definitions of technical terms should go into separate list/section of at the end of the manuscript. Also, there is a lot of information, so please summarize the data in tabular form as well for a quick glance.
- 5. The "Data" section has become a mixture of a lot of sections (results, methods, figures etc.). Please separate out the information for respective sections for a better understanding.
- 6. How did you validate your regression model? Please elaborate.

Overall, the research topic is interesting, however, the manuscript does not follow the standard structure, making it difficult to follow. The information is fragmented and need to be reorganised for a consistent story.
