- 3. A map of the study area should be included
- 4. Briefly elaborate on the multi-stage sampling used by DHS
- 5. multivariate binary logistic regression equation should be included in write-up and explanation why it was preferred to probit equations
- 6. How was wealth quintile measure in NDHS computed? Based on income, consumption or assets? Give more elaboration.
- 7. Employed women were twice likely to select a public facility compared to unemployed while the wealthier the woman, the less likely she was to choose a public facility. What could be the explanation?
- 8. What specific policy recommendations would you suggest to increase access of women to public health facility. This is not clear in the paper
