- What is the significance of this work? Maybe the author should pay more attention to stressing the novelty of this work.
- The abstract needs to be revised: background and problem statement should be briefly added to highlight the novelty of this work.
- The introduction section is excessively lengthy and should be streamlined, focusing on the novelty of this work.
- There are some typo mistakes and extra or shortened spaces in the text. I recommend authors to double-check their typo mistakes throughout the text.
- The language should be improved.
- The conclusion and summary should be clear.
- References should be updated.
