## Methods

1. How was the sample size calculated? Is there a specific formula for that?
2. Exclusion and inclusion criteria need more clarity.
3. Was the questionnaire evaluated by experts before it was conducted? Also, was it pretested?
4. CVR (Content Validity Ratio) "OR" CVI (Content Validity Index) should be mentioned to validate the degree of relevance and importance of the questionnaire contents.
5. What statistical analysis was used?
6. The ethical approval statement is also missing.
7. Also, how were the scores calculated for the questions, and what is the range for knowledge and practice scores?
