GAIA Level 2 Neonatal Death in a Preterm Live Birth is defined by three criteria: first, the infant must be live born; second, at least one of the following requirements must be met: a) Gestational age greater than or equal to 28 and less than 37 weeks (where the GA level of certainty is either level one or level two); OR b) Birth weight greater than or equal to 1000g but less than 2500g; third, the death of the infant within the first 28 days of life must be documented.
