The discussion can be improved? there are enough studies other than in Ghana that have been done on burili ulcer that can improve the document. The sample size is small. The manuscript didn't ignite all the variables in the title.

I didn't quite understand that part. The text says that in 2018, there were 56 cases in 2019, 1 case and in 2020, 21 cases. What happened between 2018 and 2020?

It would be good to specify the types of wounds that have been excluded: are they diabetic wounds, etc.? And what do you mean by seriously ill?

It would have been nice if you had taken data on the lifestyles of sufferers and non-sufferers (lifestyle diversity). This could generate data for the rest of your study.
