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The antecedents identified by the authors in this article are considered trustworthy; however, empirical testing is necessary to enhance their generalizability. Future research efforts could explore whether and how these antecedents stimulate the promotion of Electric Vehicles (EVs) in India. It would be beneficial if the findings could be generalized to provide a broader understanding for authors worldwide. Cross-sectional studies, such as surveys, may be employed to examine the validity of relationships between antecedents and EV promotion in developing countries with diverse economic and socio-environmental contexts. Meanwhile, longitudinal studies, such as case studies, could delve into the unfolding dynamics of these antecedents in resource-constrained settings within developing countries, offering an excellent opportunity for in-depth analysis. The article's emphasis on significant variations among countries categorized within developing economies serves as a valuable benchmark for researchers in exploring these dynamics.
