Here I wish to mention just a few points:

1- It would be better to mention in the title that the paper is a review article.

2-In the section on surgery, it is better to suggest that these operations should be done in high-volume centers for thyroid surgeries.

3- Another point is that during a total thyroidectomy, it would be difficult for the surgeon to explore carotid sheaths and the zones 2, 3, and 4 to check if there are any lymphadenopathies, unless the surgeon extends the incision to make a very large incision.
