General Review Recommendation:

The review article generally is very brief on concerns of re-emergence of the Monkeypox virus amidst the coronary virus pandemic .

- I strongly suggest abstract needs restructuring (remove figures provided since there would be a need for citation which is not often required in an abstract), if possible please include the type of review example narrative review in title of this noble article.
- Authors are advised to clearly differentiate the classical manifestations of Monkeypox and COVID-19 virus because as
 a clinical expert in the field differentiating between the two is clear.
- Since this is a review I expect and suggest authors to run the structure in a step wise process: Introduction and
 General Overview(references from global reliable sources can be included on current variables of the viruses); Main
 Body which discusses recent trends, treatments and any other clinical associated courses; and a Summary(inclusive
 of limitations of the review)

Clinical doctors must be aware of the several limitations of the review study a few mentioned although the study was performed by experts one should be aware of futuristic complications. All variables in the original model were consistent with data provided and all standard protocols were meet, however although major mistakes were not detected, minor corrections highlighted when addressed can be considered for publications.

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
