The topics and methods of this study are not new but are essential. This study is helpful for proper irrigation in legume cultivation in Nigeria. My main comments are as follows:

- 1. Authors should carefully check the format of the reference. I saw more than two ways of writing it. Please unify the format.
- 2. For the values in Figure 2, the decimal point symbol should be '.' instead of ','
- 3. I suggest that if the varieties, soil types, and planting time considered in the study are the main conditions in Nigeria, it can be specially stated to make the article better connected with the practice.
- 4. I think the study area's meteorological data and ET0 (ETp) should be included in the manuscript. Because this information is necessary for the subject of this study.
- 5. The symbols in the equations in the manuscript should be consistent with those in the explanation paragraph below the equation. Include the characters used and whether it is italicized or not.
- 6. I suggest that the author put the layout of the experimental plots into the manuscript or supplementary materials because the description is unclear.

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
