Thank you for your article.

I agree that there is a need to better understand the communication strategies that could be used in Virtual Project Teams, especially when it comes to international cooperation. Your analysis offers insight into the challenges that might affect this kind of communication, and the areas where some interventions and studies are more needed.

However, the methodology behind the narrative review is unclear, as well as the search strategies you used. A better understanding of how you searched the literature is very welcome, as well as a table summarizing the quality of the works you assessed.

Regarding the results of your study, I strongly recommend expanding the paragraph in order to present the data and the information you retrieved in a more analytical and objective way.

In my opinion, your "results" paragraph actually sounds more like a "Discussion" paragraph, whereas the presentation of the information you retrieved in your analysis is completely missing.

Overall, it is an interesting study that deserves diffusion among the scientific community to provide awareness of these issues, but I strongly recommend amending your text with a major review before proceeding for publication.
