

Review of: "Bisphosphonate-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaws Treated with Platelet-Rich Plasma: Preliminary Results from a Case Series"

It is a good new protocol for treatment of BRONJ. However, the manuscript should have been written in a better way, and many items are not clear enough:

- · Although BRONJ occurs more in mandible, most of patients included here had it more in maxilla.
- Define F1 correctly. It was mentioned incorrectly in different contexts.
- The surgery was not described well in details.
- It could be better to include another group with the original protocol of plasma preparation to see the advantages of the new protocol over the original one.
- No figures were included for CBCT before and after treatment.
- Number of patients was different in many locations.
- At the end of discussion, the follow up period was different from that mentioned before.
- The abbreviations are not clear.
