The topic of the paper is relevant.

The development of Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) integrated with coastal conservation education is a holistic approach that addresses the environmental, social, and economic aspects of coastal ecosystems. This integrated approach aims to empower individuals and communities with the knowledge, skills, and values necessary for sustainable development and the conservation of coastal environments.

The elements of the paper are well structured.

The research methodology is feasible with valuable supportive evidence. Nevertheless, the paper needs improvement in grammar; for instance, in the Introduction, in paragraph 6, the sentence "As a prospective educator, the effort can be made regarding this problem..." requires the article A before the word EFFORT instead of THE. Also, the author/s should consider changes in the sentence "Edukit is a tool to facilitate students' understanding of the school curriculum" — understanding OF the school curriculum instead of IN.

The Methods, Results, and Discussion sections are quite explicit.

The Conclusion section should effectively summarize the main points of the research in order to leave a lasting impression on the reader, so it would look more beneficial if the author/s extended it.
