However, while the paper mentions the participation of 15 individuals aged 20 to 40 in the UK, it would benefit from a more diverse and potentially larger sample size to ensure broader representation of user perspectives. The paper could also delve deeper into the specific findings from the semi-structured interviews and usability testing, providing more detailed insights into the identified gaps and areas for improvement.
