- 1. The title is informative and relevant; it could be more specific.
- 2. Make sure all abbreviations are written out in full the first time used. This is particularly important in the abstract and the conclusions but work through the entire manuscript carefully from this perspective.
- 3. The structure of paper needs some revision.
- 4. In the current state, there are some typographical errors. Therefore, the authors are advised to recheck the whole manuscript for improving the language and structure carefully.
